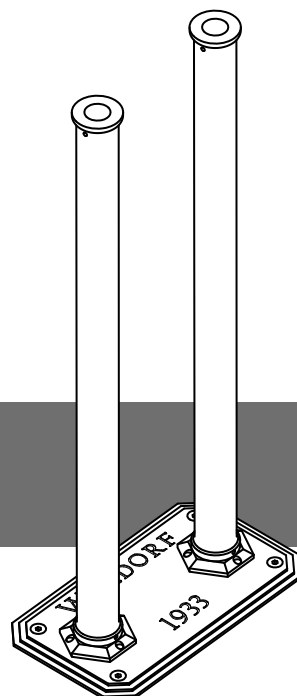

Installation Instructions



Introduction

The floor-standing legs and plate have been fully inspected throughout the production process and only leaves our factory after a 15-step QC process.

Carefully remove the floor-standing legs/plate from the box and check that all parts have been supplied.

Before beginning installation, please check for any damage that may have occurred during transport.

Note: Damage claims cannot be made during or after installation. Improper installation shall result in loss of warranty in case of damage caused by impacts or rubbing against rough surfaces. Prior to installation prepare a connection of water inlet/outlet. **IMPORTANT: Please read these instructions carefully before you begin and retain for future reference.**

We do not accept responsibility for any problems that may occur through incorrect installation.

Installation notes

The installation must comply with all plumbing codes including local codes and be installed by a licensed plumbing contractor.

Anti-scald protection is the responsibility of the installer and according to applicable codes.

Install US-AA002ROUGH first using the instructions provided with it.

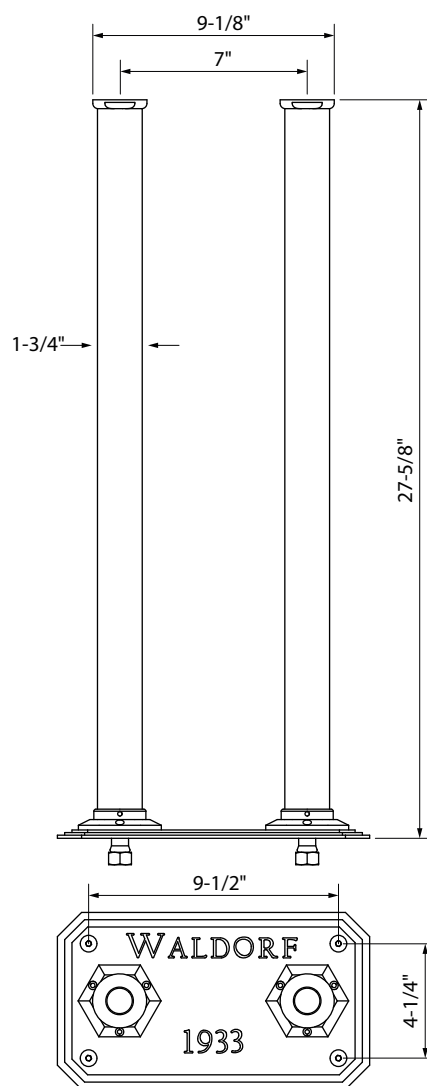
IMPORTANT! Before installing the floor-standing legs it is essential that the supply pipes are thoroughly flushed in order to remove any remaining debris, solder or other impurities. Failure to carry out this simple procedure can cause problems or damage to the working of the faucets.

Installing shut-off valves on incoming supply lines is recommended for ease of maintenance.

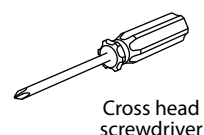
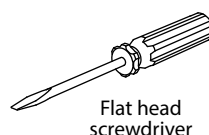
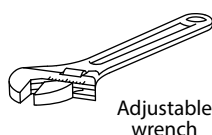
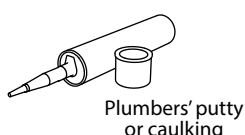
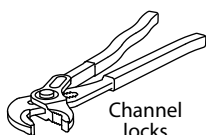
Turn off the main water supply before connecting to any existing pipework or doing any maintenance.

WARNING! Please check for any hidden pipes and cables, electric or otherwise, before drilling holes in the wall or floor.

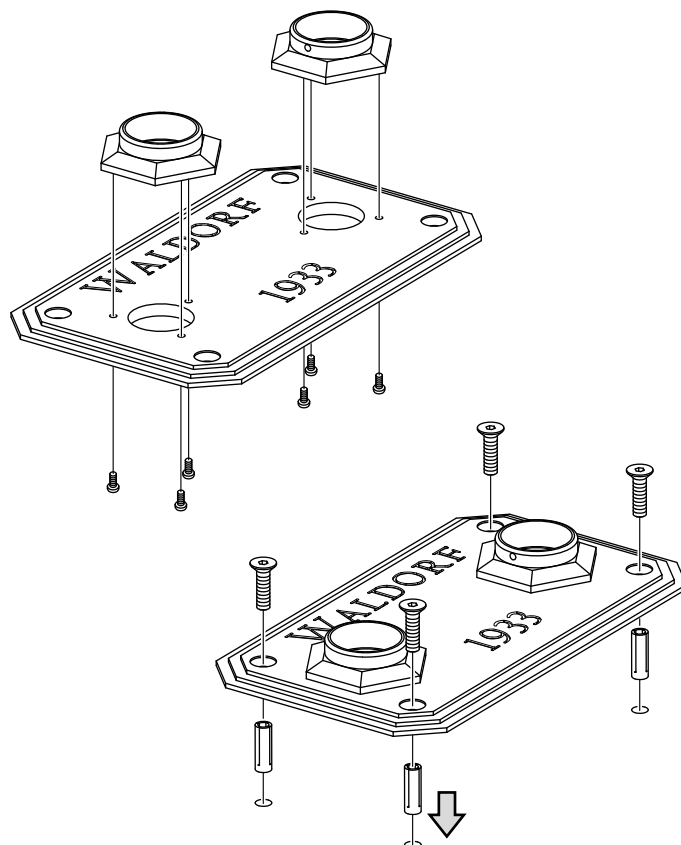


1 Installation

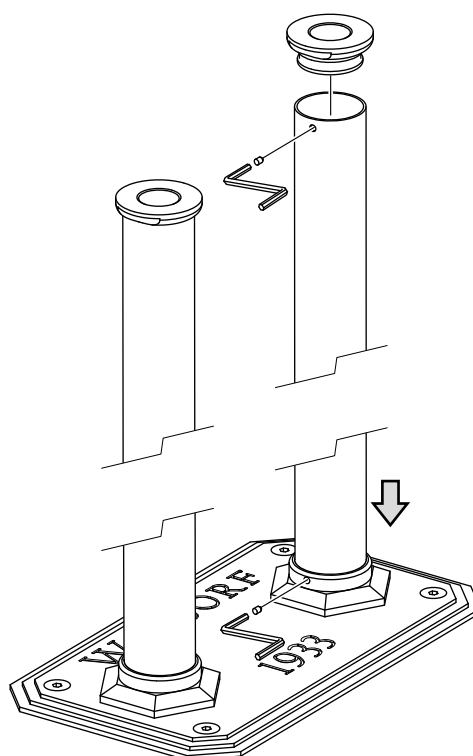
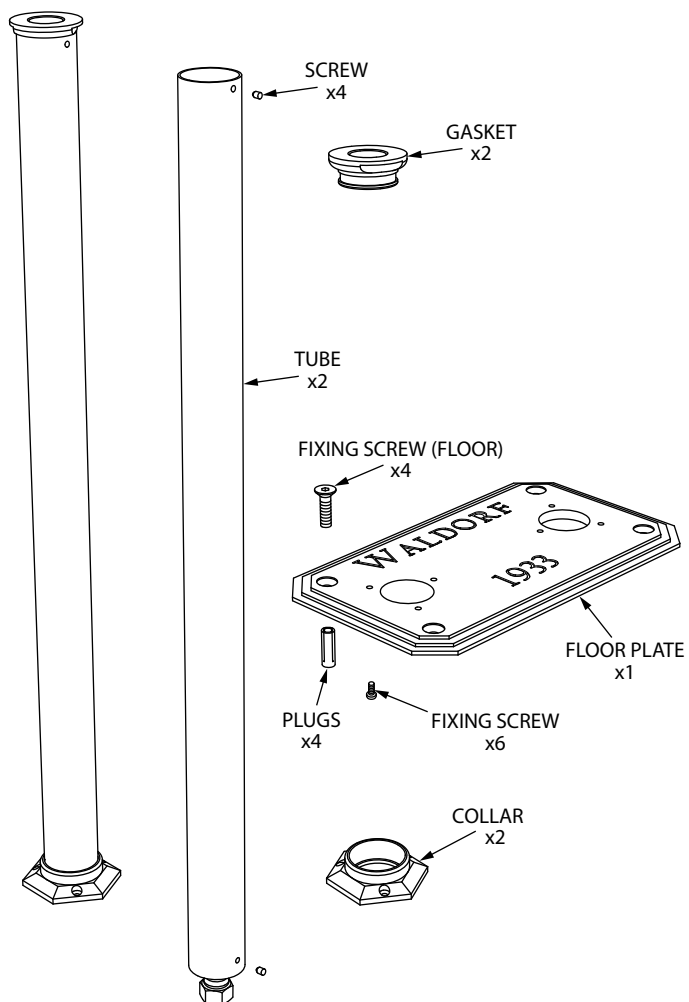
- Shut off the water heating system then, with the main water supply **turned off**, open the lowest hot and cold faucets and allow to drain until supply pipes are empty.
- Identify all components before installation.
- Before installing the floor plate on to the floor, it is necessary to fix the collars on to the plate first, as shown opposite.
- Locate the floor plate and mark the holes required. Drill 10mm holes, insert the plugs and attach the floor plate with the screws supplied, as shown opposite.
- Install the tubes into the collars and secure with a small fixing screw. Then connect both hot and cold water supplies. Use either flexible tails or suitable push-fit plastic connections.
- Install the gaskets and secure with the small fixing screws.
- Complete the finishing installation.

ATTENTION: Check all new connections for leaks.

- Turn on the main water supply, close all faucets except for the new installed faucet and as the system refills, check for leaks.
- Once satisfied there are no leaks, switch on the heating system.

3 Cleaning Instructions

Rinse away any traces of soap and gently dry with a clean, soft cloth after each use. Rinse completely with water and dry any overspray. This will maintain the finish and avoid water spotting.

To remove mineral deposits, use a 50/50 solution of white vinegar and water. Do not allow the solution to soak on the product.

Simichrome Polish® contains a protective film to enhance maintenance and is helpful in preventing water spot buildup. Follow instructions to ensure optimum results.

Never use an abrasive material such as a brush or scouring pad to clean the surface. The use of abrasive cleaners, cleansers or disinfectants will alter the surface finish and void the warranty.

Do not allow certain materials such as toothpaste, cologne, shaving cream, nail polish remover, vinegar, wine, drain and glass cleaners to remain on the surface. Prolonged contact will alter surface finishes and void the warranty.

We DO NOT recommend using any household cleaners as many can cause damage to the finish.
