





For easy installation of your faucet you will need:

- To read all warnings, care, and maintenance information.


Before beginning installation, check for any damage that may have occurred during transport. **Note: Damage claims cannot be made during or after installation.**






This valve is designed to fit into a wall that is 2 3/4" to 3 5/16" from finished wall to the back of the valve. If necessary extensions can be purchased separatley.




Best if finished wall is flush to this surface. Turn off the water supplies. Install the valve so the finished wall will fit between the markers on the mud guard.




Using mounting holes secure the valve making sure the "UP" label outlet is on top. Facing the valve, the hot supply must be on the left and the cold on the right.




Connect valve body 3/4-NPT inlets to water supplies using the proper fittings. Warning: This valve does not offer a back-to-back installation option.





Warning: If soldering is required for any connection remove the cartridge and check valve assemblies before soldering.



Connect top outlet with proper fittings. Note: it is suggested that you anchor all water lines.



1. Pressure test and flush the valve.  
a. Pressure test. check for leaks.  
b. Prior to flushing. remove cartridge and check valve assemblies.  
c. Flush the system.  
d. Remove shower outlet plug. Re-install the cartridge and check valve assemblies.  
2. Check for leaks.



This thermostatic valve has been preset at the factory to deliver water at a maximum of 120°F. If the temperature limit ring is not in the position of 120°F, please take it out, and having the left side of temperature limit ring get align with the 4th point of temperature control ring( see the arrow in red ), and then re-assembled.
